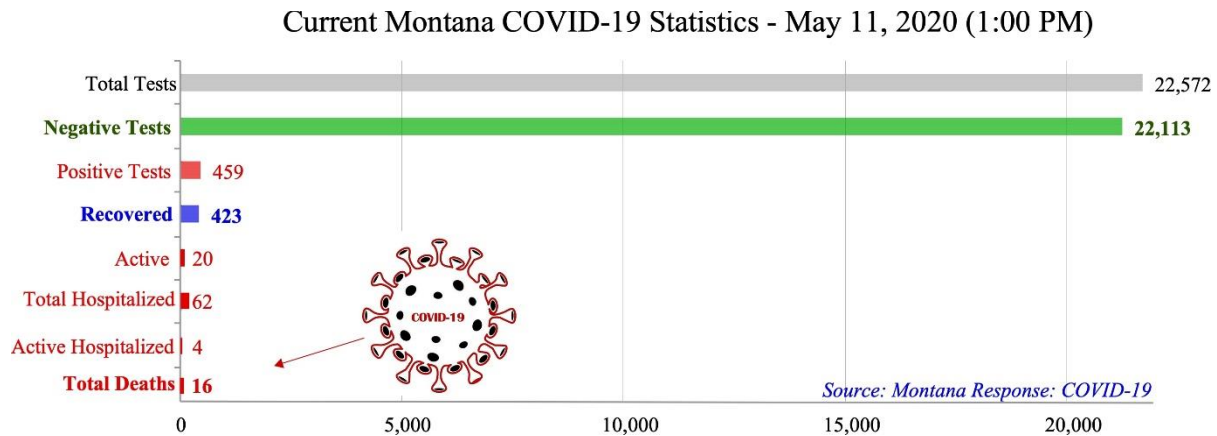


Dear Mayor and Council Members;

Here is the latest data on COVID-19 in Montana.



Notes:

- Montana had 10,200 deaths in 2017 ([statista.com](https://www.statista.com)). That is a normal death rate of 939 per 100,000 population.
- The 16 deaths from COVID-19 is a death rate of 1.5 per 100,000 population.
- This is 2/1,000th of Montana's normal death rate.
- Montana has 85 ICU Units and 2,202 hospital beds available in 17 Montana hospitals.
- There are 4 active hospitalized cases of COVID-19 in Montana.
- Of the 1,086,759 people in Montana, 459 have contacted COVID-19. That means 1,086,300 **(99.96%) did not**.
- Of the 1,086,759 people in Montana, 16 died. That means 1,086,743 **(99.9999%) did not die from COVID-19**.
