And the different sources don't show any numbers like this... This is supposed to be the "go to" data source. What is happening?


Reminds me of the joke:

I also made a few calculations and found some statistics that I found interesting.

I am at the point now where I find it hard to believe anything I see until I check it out myself, and then I am not so sure...

Montana is getting all concerned again, but when I look at the data, I have to wonder...

No doubt there are people dying of COVID-19. However we have had 280% more people die of traffic fatalities during the same time. Should we be shutting down all our highways and keeping people out of their automobiles?

**Montana (July 14, 2020 - 8:20 EDT)**

### **Tests**

Total Tests = 118,695

Negative Tests = 115,852

### **Cases**

Total Cases (Positive) = 1,843

Cases in last 7 days = 592

Cases/100K = 173.3

### **Hospitals**

Currently Hospitalized = 28

Cumulative Hospitalized = 133

In ICU = N/A

On Ventilator = N/A

Hospital Capacity = 4,005

Acute-care beds = 2,409

Intensive-care beds = 163

### **Outcomes**

Recovered = 875

Deaths = 32

Deaths/100K = 2.9

**Population** = 1,086,760

### **Statistics**

There is a **99.83%** chance that you will **NOT** contact COVID-19 in Montana

There is a **99.998%** chance that you will **NOT** die of COVID-19 in Montana.

*From New York City Health as of May 13, 2020*

*4% of those that die are 0-44 years old with underlying conditions (79%).*

*22% of those that die are 45-64 years old with underlying conditions (84%).*

*25% of those that die are 65-74 years old with underlying conditions (74%).*

*49% of those that die are 75+ years old with underlying conditions (71%).*

If you are a baby, there is a **12%** chance you **WILL** die of an abortion in Montana.

It looks like the most vulnerable (in the womb and 75+) are the ones most at risk!
